



Denver Botanic Gardens provides a limited amount of financial assistance to schools who have 50% or more participation in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP), as published by the Colorado Department of Education, or provide at least 50% of the school’s anticipated tuition through a scholarship program (proof of scholarship distribution is required). This form is **not** a program request or reservation. Assistance is made on a first come, first-served basis as follows:

### Program Fee Scholarships

- Only schools within the SCFD region are eligible.
- Only participants in Guided Programs, Discovery Days, Cultivation Cruisers or Virtual Programs are eligible for Program Fee Scholarships. Scholarships cover the program fees associated with each program.
- Self-guided visits and Planting Kits do **not** qualify for a program fee scholarship.
- Extra chaperones, above the “one chaperone per five students is free” ratio, are not covered.
- Each classroom is eligible for one scholarship per academic year.
- You may apply for a program scholarship when you submit a **school program request [online](#)**.
- Scholarship support is provided on a sliding scale according to the school’s participation in the FRLP. Support is provided to SCFD schools as follows:
